FAITH FORMATION

Dear Faith Formation Families,

Our longing to know our faith, grow our faith so that we can go in faith is present as individuals and as a community of faith. Even though the **structure of faith formation for 2020-2021** needs to be adapted this year, its importance remains the same. We realize there are various options on how best to move forward because of the challenges due to the Co-vid-19 pandemic. After a lot of thought, we have decided on the following format.

In past years, we introduced and implemented the importance and practice of “at home” sessions along with “onsite sessions.” This finds us at an advantage and ahead of the plan for this year. We will begin this year with **all “at home” sessions and sending in the interactive reviews** for each session (chapter) for **grades 1-8**. Please walk through each lesson with your children and then do the interactive reviews. Once the interactive reviews are completed send them to ffdirector@churchstjoseph.org

Grades 9-10 will be receiving their sessions and special assignments to be turned in as well.

In addition to the regular **grade 2** sessions, I will be sending preparation information for the **Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion** in January. Preparation information for the **Sacrament of Confirmation (grade 11)** will be sent as soon as possible.

Once a month there will be an online communication, offering guidance, inspiration, teaching moments as well as summarizing and posing questions based on the textbook resources. These sessions will take place via a Zoom meeting **for the children in grades 1-8 (combined) and their parents and for the students in grades 9-10 as noted on the enclosed calendars. Before each of the online Zoom meetings you will be sent a link to connect to the meeting from home.**

These plans are not optimal. Yet it seems to be the safest and most effective avenue at this point. Our faith formation enrollment is usually around 250 students and therefore onsite social distancing would be quite challenging. I trust that each family will make their child’s faith formation plan a priority and do your part to remain faithful to the promise made at the time of baptism.

Because of more “at home sessions,” we have reduced the faith formation tuition to \$50.00 from \$80.00 per child for this year even though we will still be ordering the textbooks and packet resources.
